

Participants – Geographical Reach




• 28 charities participated in the 2015 survey with an even split between National and State organisations being represented





Participants – Charity Size




• More than half of the charities have a workforce of more than 200 employees





Participants – Primary Sector




• Health, Disability and Animal make the Top 3 Primary Sectors for responders

• The total donor base for all participants is almost 7 million, with 1.4 million identified as Active





Fundraising Income – Overall and Bequest




- There is a jump in overall income between 2013 and 2014 due to the increase in the number of responses
- Total Fundraising income for 2015 participants was reported at \$717m





Fundraising Income – Overall and Bequest




- Of those participants who responded for all 3 years, the change is quite small
- Total Fundraising income for 2015 participants (who also provided 2013 and 2014 income), was reported at \$404m





Fundraising Income – Bequest Income by Type




- Where Bequest Type was not supplied the Income was allocated to Unknown
- Almost 60% of Bequest Income is from Residuals, and a third was not specified by participants
- The remainder was split between Pecuniary Bequests and Perpetual Trusts





Fundraising Income – Average Total Bequest Income




- Where the participants specified the type of Bequest received in the survey, this shows the average total of that income across all participants (total income not the average value of the Bequest itself)
- The Total Average Bequest Income across all participants is \$3.9m





Fundraising Income – Average Bequest Value



- Where specified, the Average Residual Bequest value is almost 3 times higher per payment than Pecuniary or Perpetual Trusts
- Although there is almost the same average number of Residual Bequest and Perpetual Trusts, the average value of Trusts is significantly lower
- The overall Average Bequest gift is \$49,096 across the 3 Bequest types





Bequest Detail – Death Notification Types




- Fairly even split between Residuals and Pecuniary Notifications in 2015
- The average number of notifications for respondents was 22





Bequest Detail – whether known to Charity




• Almost 75% of the Bequests realised in 2015 were from known donors (although it was not known there was a gift in their will) and the remainder was from gifts that were known in advance of the notification

Bequest Detail – Confirmed Bequestors




• Of the 28 respondents the total Confirmed Bequestors is 18,552 with an average of 663





Bequest Detail – Confirmed-to-Realised Ratio



- These ratios differ greatly between Survey Respondents (who are anonymised in this chart)
- The ratio is defined as the number of Confirmed Bequestors on file divided by the number of realised Bequests in that year
- The Confirmed-to-Realised Ratio across all respondents is 20.43





Bequest Activities – Program Summary




- Of the 28 Responders, only 3 Charities do not have an Active Bequest program although they did confirm they still conduct Donor Surveys
- The most common Bequest activity amongst the responders was to send out Bequest Surveys





Bequest Activities – Program Development



- Of all responders, 54% have a Dedicated Bequest Team/Person
- For those who did not have a Dedicated Bequest Team/Person, they describe a lack of resources as the main reason
